Reflection on Step Five

I'm reminded of how many secrets I had to keep before I found OA. No one knew that I regularly binged on sweets and snack foods by myself in the dark. No one knew the efforts I went to to hide the empty boxes, bags and cartons, to replace the food I stole in the night, to hide my swollen body from discerning eyes, to "get rid" of the binges through gut-wrenching workouts and days of starvation and deprivation. I pasted a smile on my face and tried to convince everyone, especially myself, that I was okay. I was not okay. I was suffering through the now obvious symptoms of compulsive eating, but I couldn't admit it to anyone. I couldn't trust anyone with my secrets.

Then I came to OA, and found people freely admitting that they did those same crazy things with food that I had been hiding from the world since I was 7 years old. They had the same self destructive impulse I had. They understood. I started to believe that getting honest about my problems wouldn't destroy me - in fact, it might even help me. After all, many of the people I encountered in the rooms seemed to be living joyful, balanced lives. Maybe talking honestly about my challenges with food might help me get well, too.
